In this unique experience you will meet the Embera tribe called Drua, located in the Rio Chagres National Park.

We offer you the opportunity to share a day with this tribe rich in traditional culture.

Along the tour you will enjoy natural sites, a river with a historic past, waterfalls, ethnic background, Embera tattoos, indigenous food and their crafts.

# EL VALLE VILLAGE INSIDE A VOLCANO



We will begin our adventure by heading to Anton's

Valley, a small town settled in a volcano's crater formed a million years ago.

The Valley has a lot of great sites to offer: the crafts Market (open only on Sundays), pre-Columbian hieroglyphics, warm water springs, the Valley museum, the Nispero Zoo and Botanical Garden, where you can enjoy several plant and animal species, including the golden frogs.

We will then enjoy the Canopy Adventure 3 stations, from which you will enjoy the splendorous rainforest.

## CITY TOUR - VISIT THE THREE CITIES (4 hours)

We will begin our tour by visiting the ruins of Panamá la Vieja (Old Panama), city which was founded by the Spaniards in 1519. This city played a major role in the conquest of South America and functioned as capital of Castilla de Oro. It was destroyed by the pirate Henry Morgan in 1671. Our next stop will be el "Casco Antiguo de Panamá", the Old City, where one can still see colonial style architecture. We offer as well the possibility to visit the Canal Museum. We will end our historical visit of Panama with a tour of the modern city, the banking area and new places of interest



## MIRAFLORES LOCKS (2 1/1 HOURS)

We will visit Miraflores Locks and its new Visit Center, where you'll be able to see the transit of vessels and to receive an explanation regarding the operations of the Canal.



## SHOPPING IN PANAMA -Albrook Mall (4 Hours Max)

We will start our day early to go shopping to the modern Albrook Mall. We will provide a driver/guide to make your shopping day more comfortable and enjoyable. We offer this tour everyday, except holidays.



## TOUR OF PANAMA CITY AND THE PANAMA CANAL (8 HOURS)

We will first stop at Miraflores Center, for a full explanation regarding the Canal.



We will then continue to el "Casco Antiguo", the Old City, where one can still admire old colonial style buildings, the old wall that surrounded the city, the dungeons of the colonial prison and the "Plaza de Francia", a monument donated by France.

We will stop at the Amador Causeway, where one can admire the Panama Bay and the Canal exit into the Pacific Ocean.

We will then visit the ruins of "Panama La Vieja" (Old Panama), city founded by the Spaniards in 1519.

## PARTIAL TRANSIT OF THE PANAMA CANAL.(4 – 5 Hrs)

We are offering this tour every Saturday, excepting the ones in which we offer the complete transit. It includes transportation to the dock where we will be boarding a ship that will take you through the Miraflores and Pedro Miguel Locks, where you will appreciate how the Canal works, as well as, the Miraflores and Gamboa Lakes.



## COMPLETE TRANSIT OF THE PANAMA CANAL. (1 day)

Once a month we offer you the opportunity to enjoy a full transit through the Panama Canal. We will be departing from the Balboa Port in the Pacific and going through the three locks: Miraflores, Pedro Miguel and Gatun. We will arrive in Colon City in the Atlantic.

## HISTORIC PORTOBELLO TOUR (6 Hours)

We will be traveling to the province of Colon, where the ruins of Portobello City are located. You will enjoy the fortress, the defenses and the batteries between a beautiful landscape of ocean and mountains. We will also be visiting the Santiago de la Gloria Castle, the Customs, the San Jeronimo Castle, the San Felipe Church where the famous Portobello's Black Christ is located and other places of historic interest.



## TRANSISTMIC TRAIN RIDE. (1 Day)

Our journey will begin in Panama City where we will board the re-inaugurated Panama Canal Railroad, originally used by gold hunters in 1849 as a safe way to cross the continent without being pursued by Indians. During the ride you will be able to enjoy the exuberant views of the tropical rainforest. The tour includes a tour along the Panama Canal and visits to the rainforest. This tour include the Historic Portobello also.
